PRELUDE: 'For the Beauty of the Earth'' Hanna Noh

GREETING: We are here today to celebrate the greatness of God...all of His blessings great and small. We greet God as we greet each other, acknowledging God among us in this time and place. We ask that this time of worship is blessed so that we may be uplifted by His presence.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

ASBURY MISSION STATEMENT: We are Asbury! Abundantly thankful to God; Saved by Christ's resurrection; Blessed by God; United by Christ's love for each of us; Reaching out to our church family and our community; Yearning to tell the Good News to all by being Christ's voice, hands, and feet in the world.

MOMENT OF SILENCE: We pause this morning to refocus ourselves and our energies on the true purpose of gathering together. Allow for silence to calm your mind, body and soul. Be still and know that He is God.

CENTERING HYMN: UMH #334 Sweet, Sweet Spirit.

CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: We see light, hope and joy. We bring heart, soul, mind and body. We share blessings and fears. We bring faith and doubt.

P: With all that we are and all that we have, let us worship God.

L: A time set apart, a time to come together: a space filled with silence, a space filled with song, hearts seeking solace, hearts overflowing with joy.

P: This is the day that the Lord has made. Let us worship God.

L: Joy, wonder, delight. Doubt, peace, restlessness. Sorrow, contentedness anxiety. Confidence, hope, pardon. We lay our hearts full of these things before our God. Unburdened and awaiting.

P: Let us worship God

L: There is silence, and there is light. There is music, and there is grace. There are people and there is life. There is hope...

P: And there is God. Let us worship well today.

L: Look around. Listen carefully. Peer into your heart. What do you see? What do you hear? What do you find?

P: Let us seek the presence of God in this moment. And let us worship Him.

L: For summer graces, for worship music, for beaches and mountains and flowers, for prayers asked and answered, for a sense of peace, and a sense of hope:

P: For all these things we give thanks and worship the One who gives them to us.

L: God is here! How do we know that? Do you hear the rustle of papers? Does your heart sing a little with the music? Do tears come unbidden to your eyes? Do you look across the sanctuary and see someone who makes you smile? Do you feel gladness in this space? That is of God. The rustle, the song, the tears, the smile, the gladness – those point to the holy.

ALL: And God is holy. Let us worship and celebrate God's day. AMEN.

1st Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in all circumstance; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

(Thank God no matter what happens. This is the way God wants you who belong to Christ Jesus to live...even in the challenging times.)

Luke 12: 6-7 Five sparrows are sold for only two pennies, and God does not forget any of them. But God knows how many hairs you have on your head. Don't be afraid. You are worth much more than many sparrows.

(Sparrows in the Bible represent how far the Creator's love extends for creation. While people may overlook sparrows, God always sees them and cares about them. Sparrows show us that no creature – no matter how small or common – is beyond the reach of God's love.)

Zechariah 4:10 An angel of the Lord told the prophet, "The people should not think that small beginnings are unimportant."

(Whatever your circumstance, whatever the kingdom task that looms before you, don't despise today because your initial efforts seem small and insignificant.)
